The evolving nature of this event requires us to be flexible in how we respond. We are closely monitoring and following the guidance of the Centre of Disease Control (CDC) and World Health Organization (WHO) to ensure we are doing our part to keep you and our communities safe. Here are some ways we are taking action:

- All staff are washing their hands every 30 min
- Additional hand sanitizing stations have been added in highly trafficked locations
- Increased frequency of disinfecting and sanitization in high traffic areas for our guests and staff in areas such as restrooms, food halls, seating areas, pub and bar areas, door handles, tables, all check in counters in tickets, rentals, snow school and group check in as well as communal computer workstations, phones credit card and debit machines and radio coms.
- making changes to our Food and Beverage procedures
- changed our lift loading procedures to allow for social distancing and for guests to choose their own groupings
