SNOW MAKERS

These positions start early in November and run 24/7 until opening and then are restricted to evenings & nights in December. Experience preferred but not required. Must be physically able to adjust and move equipment in cold temperatures.

Lift attendants assist guests with loading and unloading chairs and are constantly watching out for safety. Must be able to work long hours outdoors in cold temperatures while providing friendly and safe customer service.



LIFT ATTENDANTS

Training will be providing in all aspects of lift operations. Full and part time positions available.



SKI & SNOWBOARD INSTRUCTORS

RENTAL ATTENDANTS



TICKETS COUNTER

Tickets counter clerks must have operations knowledge of lift, rental, and snow school options. They are responsible for cash handling and reconciling sales at the end of the day. Must be friendly, outgoing and good with cash.

These positions start early in November and run 24/7 until opening and then are restricted to evenings & nights in December. Experience preferred but not required. Must be physically able to adjust and move equipment in cold temperatures.



BAR WAIT STAFF

FOOD COURT CASHIER

This position will be responsible for cash drawer, including receiving cash, administering change, processing visa and debit transactions. Cashiers are also responsible for counting cash and reconciling sales at the end of the day including other duties as assigned.

KITCHEN/FOOD COURT COUNTER ATTENDANTS

Duties include taking orders, preparation of food and other duties as assigned. Individuals must be friendly and have good customer service skills.
