The Terrain Park Supervisor will be responsible for the Terrain Park(s) design and operations in adherence to the vision/strategy as set forth by the Asessippi Ski Area Senior leadership team. The Terrain Park Supervisor will ensure that the delivered product provides its users with an excellent guest experience which includes administering and implementing the policies and procedures as they relate to the Terrain Park(s). The Terrain Park Supervisor will also ensure that the Terrain Park(s) are operated in an efficient and cost-effective manner including the scheduling and related training of the Terrain Park Team.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES (include but not limited to the following):

- Oversee design construction and the constant care and maintenance of rail features and jumps, knowledge of when a feature should be open or closed, ensuring all signage, fencing and park entrances are in order, inspecting features to ensure that they are safe for the public. Monitoring and fixing any and all equipment.
- Ensure that the Terrain Park(s) meet the needs of our Guests and follow the strategy as defined by the Asessippi Management team.
- Works closely with the Outdoor Operations Supervisor to manage available resources in the build and maintenance phases of each park.
- Recruiting, training and supervision of the Terrain Park Team and key volunteers.
- Develop open communication pathways and strive to develop strong working relationships with all related departments and Department Supervisors at Asessippi Ski Area and Resort.

- Work with Snow School Management in the design, implementation and evaluation of Terrain Park based programming.
- Ensure due diligence in both the construction and maintenance of parks with the intent of minimizing risk to the end user and minimizing liability to Asessippi Ski Area including development of policies and procedures as required.
- Document and file all signage and features upon installation and any redesigns.
- Maintenance of official records and documents as required.
- Ensure compliance with governmental laws, rules and regulations.
- Ensure compliance with Worksafe MB rules and regulations and Asessippi Ski Area Policies and Procedures.
- Adhere to and ensure compliance of the Department in regards to the Risk Management program and all aspects that pertain to the operation of the Terrain Park(s).

In conjunction with the Asessippi Ski Area Marketing Department:

- Work closely in organizing and executing events.
- Service and maintain current relationships with sponsors and associated corporate sponsor agreements.
- Support the Marketing Department for a Terrain Park marketing plan with content, video, photos including regular terrain park updates on current, new and upcoming additions, features and events.
- Work with the Marketing Department in the promotion of Terrain Park specific programming.
